

## **Rollover effects using tweened animation**

To make a button that is animated when the mouse is over it, follow these three steps:

1. Prepare Graphic
2. Make animated movie clip using the graphic
3. Make a button with the graphic and animated movie clip

### **Prepare Graphic:**

Insert | Symbol | Graphic

Make or import the graphic for the button

### **Make animated movie clip:**

Insert | Symbol | Movie clip

Drag the graphic into the movie clip

Click in frame 30

Insert | Keyframe

Click in in-between frames

In Frame panel,

    Tweening: Motion

    Easing : 1

    Rotate: CW 1 time

Script last frame: gotoAndPlay(1)

Return to scene

### **Make button:**

Insert | Symbol | Button

Drag graphic into “Up” frame

Click on “Over” frame

Insert | Keyframe

Delete graphic from Over frame

Drag the movie clip with the animation onto the stage

Click on the “Down” frame

Insert | Keyframe

Delete the movie clip from the frame

Drag the movie clip onto the frame

Return to the scene

Drag the button onto the stage

To view the rollover effect, press control + return
